SJICF Scholarship Fund - Goal \$5,000

Help open the door to higher education for local students. Scholarship recipients are high school graduates and members of our island community who wish to further their education at an accredited community college, two-year college, four-year college, or career/vocational program.



Museum of History & Industry Expansion Project - Goal \$5,000

An interactive educational facility is currently being developed at the San Juan Historical Museum to interpret and exhibit the living history of four industries that shaped and sustained San Juan Island for generations: Fishing, Farming, Logging and Lime. The museum will house 5 separate sections & will be completed by late 2016.



Islands Oil Spill Association Equipment Trailer - Goal \$3,500

Several of the trailers used to store vital oil spill response gear have been in service for over 20 years, and it is time to purchase a new Cargo-Mate 10° x 6° supply trailer for the Roche Harbor storage site. Supply trailers keep necessary equipment at the ready, and reduce valuable response time so that spills can be cleaned up most efficiently.



Women's Fund Membership Drive - Goal \$2,500/25 New Members

The Women's Fund was established to provide a collective way for women to get involved in reviewing and evaluating grant awards that have been approved by the Foundation's Grants Committee. The goal of this membership drive is to increase membership from 120 to 145 members. The minimum annual membership donation is \$100.



Animal Protection Society New Shelter - Goal \$5,000

Time and island growth have rendered the current animal shelter inadequate to safely accommodate the ever increasing number of animals. The new shelter will be a state-of-the-art facility that incorporates highly durable, specialized materials and equipment to keep animals safe and comfortable.



Islands Museum of Art New Building - Goal \$5,000

IMA's new structure will rise from the old EMS building and become a top-rate venue for local artist showcases, visiting exhibitions, art workshops, and incomparable educational opportunities for youth and adults. Construction is well underway, and the completion date is targeted for mid-November 2014.



Family Resource Center Youth Mentoring Program - Goal \$5,000

Mentoring is a way for adults and kids alike to experience quality time together and make a positive difference in each other's lives. Mentors in the program are provided with training, orientation and supervision to help the children they work with build positive social skills, feel special and develop their potential.



Band Families & Friends Musical Instrument Repair & Replacement - Goal \$2,700

A music student is far more likely to succeed musically if motivated by a functional, pleasant sounding instrument. This project will fix many school instruments that are in disrepair, and replace a few that are beyond repair, for the students in the seven bands at Friday Harbor Middle and High Schools.
