Registration for Winter Quarter classes is going on now at Skagit Valley College:

- Registration for **Returning Students** going on now.
- Registration for **New Advised Students** starts Thursday, November 20.
- **Open Enrollment** starts Thursday, December 4.
- Winter Quarter begins Tuesday, January 6.
