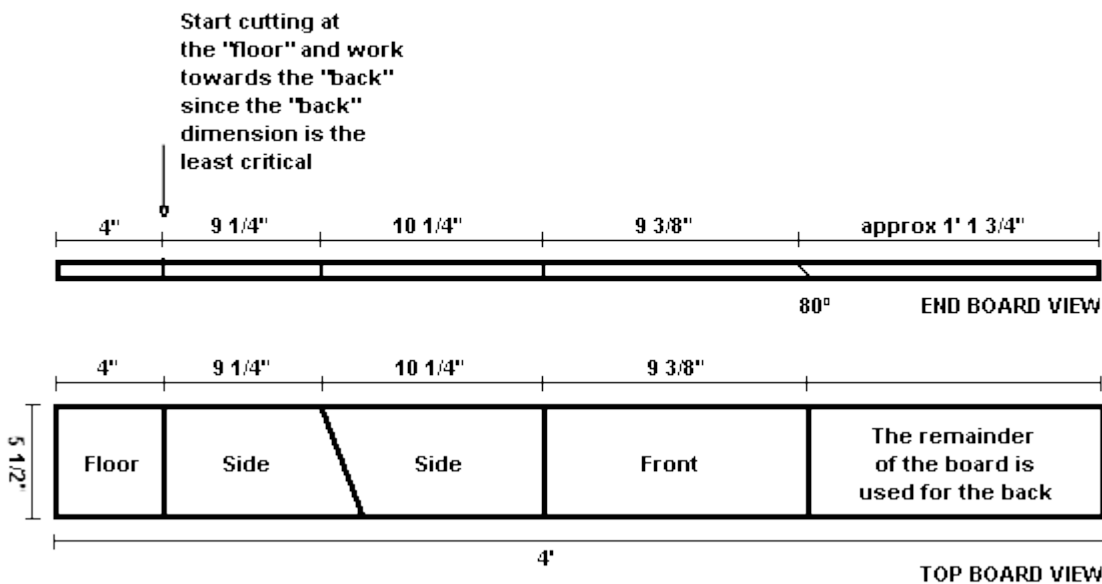


Eastern or Western Bluebird Nestbox

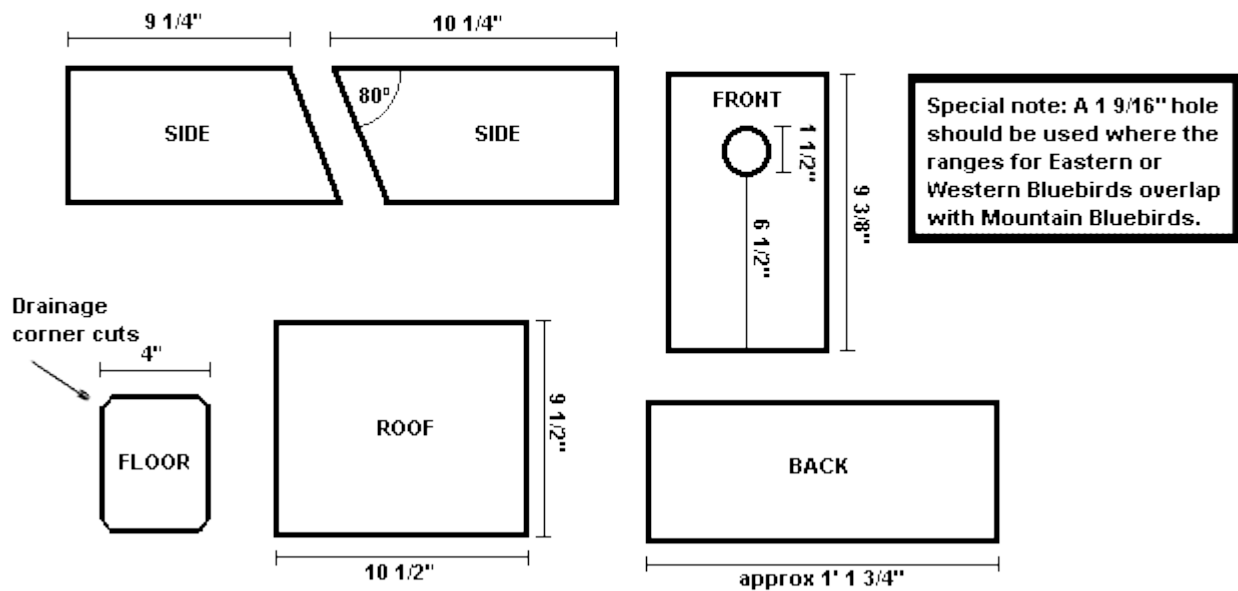
MATERIALS LIST

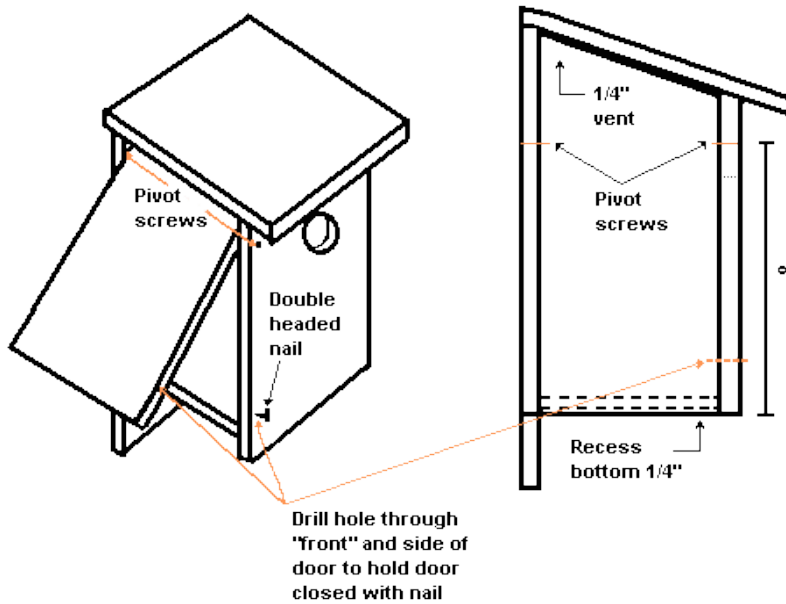
- Standard board 1" x 6" x 4' long
- Standard Board 1" x 10" x 10 1/2" long (for roof)
- 1-3/4" galvanized nails or screws -- approx. 20
- 1-3/4" galvanized screw or nail for pivot point -- 2
- Double-headed nail for holding door closed -- 1

CONSTRUCTION PLAN





This side view shows how the box opens on the side for cleaning and access to band chicks. The access hole for the birds is on the front.

The box is nailed to a post or tree on the extension at the back bottom of the box and above in the middle of the back. Access to the middle is through the front hole using a long-handled screwdriver.
