
### Stand Up Men

### The Challenge

Domestic violence and sexual assault are real problems in the San Juan Islands.

- One out of three women and one out of six men nationwide will experience some form of sexual violence in their lifetime. Domestic violence is even more common. According to the San Juan County Sheriff's Department, domestic violence accounts for more than half of all the calls they receive\*. (\*More info at safesj.org/resources)
- Domestic violence and sexual assault have a long-lasting impact on survivors, family members, friends, and community members in the San Juan Islands.
- In addition to the human toll, these assaults are financially costly to our community:
  - Staff costs for law enforcement, prosecuting attorneys and public defenders.
  - Direct client and survivor advocacy services.
  - Counseling for survivors, family members, friends and community members.
  - Safe housing for survivors.

### **Lack of Funding**

SAFE San Juans is a nonprofit agency. They receive federal, state, and local funding for administration, staff salary, and direct client services – **but only 4.7% of those funds are able to go towards prevention and education efforts.** This leaves an approximate deficit of \$45,000 for prevention education.

### The Solution

Community and school prevention education cost effectively reduce and prevent these types of violence.\*

SAFE San Juans currently provides these services to islanders:

- Crisis Intervention and Counseling
- Advocacy Services
- Legal Advocacy
- Medical Advocacy
- Safety Planning
- School and Community Prevention
- Therapy

However more funding is needed for school and community prevention education.
